YEAR CINQ - 1796-1797

19 Nov 1796 (29 brumaire 5)

Arnout Standaert (maybe **Snanwaert?** See other films), 50 (cinquant?), c1746, b. Zomegem, married to Agnes De (Reiw) of Maldegem. "swore before me... qu'il s'etait commik un suicide in the town of..."
Witness: Pierre Jacques DeSmet, Phillippe Dobbelaere and others... plus "gard"(police?)

7 Jan 1797 (18 nivose 5) died 6th

Jeanne Carolina Standaert, 10 days, (c Dec 1796), of Ambroise Standaert and Theresia DeZutter, 31 (c1766)
Witness: Ambrosius Standaert, marchand, age 32, c1765, and Jan Matthys, aubergist (innkeeper), 45, died at house in Stroobrugge. Signed by Joannes Matthys and A. Standaert

23 Apr 1797 (quarte floreal 5)

(S/B **Jean Francois**, but says **Francois only**) **Francois Standaert**, marchal, age 35, (trente cinq?), c1762, married to: Ann Van der Haegen
Witness: Pierre Standaert, marchal ferrant (blacksmith), 30, c1767, (cousin germain=1st cousin) and Charles DeLille, boulanger (baker), 52 (voisin=neighbor)

14 Sep 1797 (28 fructidor 5)

Joseph Geirnaert, of Pierre and Anne Marie Standaert

19 Sep 1797 (3 Complementaire "extra" 5) d. 28 Fructidor or 14 Sep 1797

Noe DeZutter, rentier, 66, of Pierre DeZutter and Jeanne DeZutter
Witness: Robert DeZutter, son, cultivator, 35 and Mattheus Seglieve, 48, journalier (farmer), neighbor and friend

YEAR SIX

18 Apr 1798 (29 germinal 6) **Jacques Bernard Teirlinck's Sister and Brother??

Marie Petronella Teirlinck, 46 (quarante six), c1752, born Adegem, of (Dionik? Denis, later??) Teirlinck and Jeanne Marie D'holbeke.
Witness: Jean Teirlinck, marchand, 59, c1739, (frere=brother), and Pierre Goethals, 40 voisin (neighbor)

5 May 1798 (seize floreal six) d. 4 May 1798 (quinze)

Cosmas Damiens Standaert, 74 (soixante quatre?), of Jean Standaert (ok) and Anna Maria Kepp(ens) (**wrong? S/b Veronica Keppens?), died in EEDE on 4 May 1798, north sector, department of Lieve, at house of Jean Standaert. (OTHER DATE: from Pierre Standaert marriage on 3 Jun 1807, lists death at 4 May 1799?).

Witness: Jean Standaert, son, unreadable occup, 29, c1769, and Phillipe Moenhaut, musician, neighbor and friend (voisin), of Eede.

Additional note at bottom: something like vouching death recorded in Maldegem, verifying actually died in Eede?

30 Jul 1798 (deuze thermidor 6)

Ferdinand Standaert, of Mald. 20, of Pierre Laurent Standaert, and Jeanne Marie Verstringhe

Witness: Pierre Standaert (frere=brother), marchal ferrant(blacksmith), 32, c1766 and Jean Standaert, worker, 26, c1772, aufri frere (other brother). SIGNED: Pierre and Joannes Standaert

18 Apr 1799 (29 germinal 7)

Jeanne Therese Standaert, 2 months (douze mois), of Pierre (judic?) and Petronella Gaillaert

Witness: Pierre Standaert, father, blacksmith, 32, c1767

23 Jun 1799 (cinq messidor sept)

Anne Marie DeBruyckere, 12 (douze ans), c1787, of Ange DeBruyckere and Jeann Timmerman

Witness: Ange de Bruyckere, worker, father, age 60, c1739

8 Aug 1799 (21 thermidor 7)

Sophie Eeckman, 11 months, of Jean Eeckman and Anna van der Haegen

Witness: Jean Eeckman, blacksmith, age 26, c1773

18 Sep 1799 (deux Complemaentaire 7) Page 142

Caroline Hebbelinck, 27, c1772, of Pierre Hebblelinck and Anna Marie DeBaere

Witness: Pierre van den Bossche, journalier, age 31 c1768

29 Dec 1799 (douze nivose 8)

Charles Verstraete, b Mald. Age 43 days, c Nov 1799, of Pierre, cabertier, 42, c1757, and Monique Standaert

22 Jan 1800 (deux pluviose 8)

Pierre Verstraete, cabertier, age 42 c1758, b. Mald, of Pierre and Catherina Van Vooren, b. Sint Laurent, Husband of Monique Standaert

Witness: Brother- Jacques Verstraete, 53 c1747

20 Feb 1800 (1 ventose 8)

Pierre Jean De Busschere, 4 days, of Pierre, journalier, 26, and Barbe Rombaut (who??)

14 Mar 1800 (23 ventose 8)

Petronella DeZutter, 73 (soixante treize), c1727, b. Mald of Pierre (b Mald) and Jeanne DeZutter (b. Mald). And widow of Jacques Willems

Witness: Jacques Willems, 36, c1764, son

31 Oct 1800 (9 Brumaire 9) Page 209

Angeline DePoorter(e), b. Mald, of Jacques de Poortere, 36, c1764, b. Ooseamp?, of Anna Marie Hebbelinck, 34. NO Age for Angeline...

Witness: Jacques and Francois Lasoen, journalier, 31, vuele

10 Nov 1800 (19 Brumaire 9) Page 212

Jacques Bernard DeBaere, 5 yrs, c1795, b. Mald of Pierre Jacques, 56, c1744, and Catherine Pinthelou, 40, c1760, b. Brugge

21 Nov 1800 (21 Brumaire 9) Page 213

Ambrois DeBaere, 6 yrs and 6 months, b. Mald, of Pierre Jacques DeBaere, 56, and Catherine Pinthelou, b. Brugge parish of Saint Egide.

11 Jan 1801 (21 Nivose 9), Page 227, died 20th

Marie Theresia Hoste, 8 months, of Jean Hoste, 44, b. Eede and Isabella Virmarcke, 31, (nerlit?) d Westcappelle.

11 Feb 1801 (22 Pluviose 9), Page 235 d. 10th

Joseph Francois Eeckman 7 months, b. Mald of Jean Eeckman, 27, c1774, b. Kolkerke, blacksmith, and Anna Maria Van den haegen, 36, c1765

20 Feb 1801 (1 ventose 9) , Page 238 d.20th (hui)

Marie TIERLYNCK, 72 (soixante douze), c1729, b. native Mald., widow (veuve) of Francois Cauwels, and parents were Francois Tierlynck and Petronella Vergauwe.

Witness: Pierre Van de Walle, 44, beau fils (son in law, stepson), and Pierre Cauwels, 33, "qui a dit etre fils"

29 May 1801 (9 Prairial 9) d. 28th

Anne Marie Hebbelinck, 3 months, decide hier, of Ferdinand, age 25, c1776, and Petronella Vernaije (have Gernaey/Garnaey in rest), of Maldegem. **Witness:** father

YEAR DIX

29 Oct 1801 (7 brumaire 10) pg 266 d. 28th

Laurent Blondeel, 79 (soixante dix neuf), c1722, b. Mald of Francoise Blondeel and Petronella (Ronse). Spouse was Joanna Van Wassenhove.

Witness: Pierre Blondeel, 54, c1747, and Ambroise Blondeel, 32, 1769, (both "fild du d'enf..")

20 Dec 1801 (29 Frimaire 10), pg 271, d. 19th

Unnamed DeZutter, of Pierre DeZutter and Marie Van Wassenhove

29 Jan 1802 (9 Pluviose 10), pg 277, d. 28th

Barbe Blondeel, 50, c1752, b. Mald, Spouse was Jean (Creffyn), of Jean Blondeel and Therese Hugaert.

Witness: Jean Blondeel, 41, c1761, brother

15 Mar 1802 (24 ventose x), pg 283, d.14th ****Jacques and his two brothers? And sister=Marie Petr?***

Jean Teirlinck, 63, c1739, born Adegem, of Denis Teirlinck and Jeanne D'Holbeke, "juin homme"?

Witness: Pierre Tierlinck, 54, c1748, and Jacques Tierlinck, 58, c1744, duex freres (two brothers)

5 May 1802 (15 Floreal x), pg 290, d. 13th

Jacques Bernard Hebbelinck, 23 days, of Ferdinand, 26 and Petronella Gernaey

27 May 1802 (7 prairial x), pg 292
